### How much will it cost?

All of our current beginners course fees and group discount figures are listed on our website, all of **our prices** are fully inclusive!

You'll notice we offer an "interest free" payment scheme for all our courses allowing you to pay over monthly instalments if preferred!

### Are there any restrictions on age or health?

The minimum age for all courses is 16 and you must be in good health and weigh no more than the maximum weight limit for your chosen course. There is no upper age limit for Tandem Skydiving, however to qualify for solo parachute training you mustn't be over the age of 55.

If you're aged 40 or over, or suffer from certain medical conditions such as ... epilepsy, fits, severe head injury, recurrent blackouts or giddiness, disease of the brain or nervous system, high blood pressure, heart or lung disease, recurrent weakness or dislocation of any limb, diabetes, mental illness, drug or alcohol addiction... you will need to get a medical form (which we can either send you or you can print off our web site) signed by your doctor before you can take part.

If you're under the age of 18 this medical form, along with an additional membership form, will need to be signed by your parent or guardian giving their permission for you to train and jump.

#### Is the centre approved by the British Parachute Association?

Yes. The centre is approved by both the British Parachute Association and Civil Aviation Authority - who perform regular inspections to ensure all the latest safety requirements are met. All the instructors are British Parachute Association qualified.

#### What happens if the weather affects my jump?

If the weather prevents your jump from taking place on the initial day you will be able to reschedule it for another mutually convenient occasion within a set time period at no extra cost; Six months for tandem skydives, three months for solo courses.

We are open for jumping almost every day of the week.

#### Can I have my jump videoed / photographed?

Yes. All courses have air to air videos or photographs available for an additional fee. These can be organised on the day.

#### Is overnight accommodation available?

Yes. Should you wish to stay over night for whatever reason you can camp on the airfield free of charge or stay in the airfield house for a small fee. Local hotels are also available.

Toilets and showers are available on site.

#### Is food and drink available?

Yes. Food and drink is available on site throughout the day. We also have a club bar which opens once the last flight of the day has landed.

#### Are spectators allowed?

Yes. We have specifically designated areas where they can sit and watch the parachuting.
